



COVID-19 Worker & Employer Safety & Prevention Recommendations 2021 Season

Testing recommendations:

- Weekly and/or daily testing is not recommended by FHLC. Daily screening with temperature checks and symptom reporting is recommended.
- FHLC continues to provide employer and employee risk mitigation strategy education. This education includes masking, particularly with knowledge of the risks of congregate living, and work that is often performed in close proximity of other workers in mind.
- FHLC continues to provide COVID-19 testing services. Any Migrant/Seasonal Agricultural Worker (MSAW) employer can contact FHLC to schedule a testing clinic if they choose to test employees prior to the start of work. FHLC follows up with any positive cases and with employers (with patient permission) to provide isolation education.
- **NEW:** Fully vaccinated people who have come into close contact with someone suspected or confirmed to have COVID-19 should be tested 3-5 days after exposure and wear a mask in public indoor settings for 14 days or until they receive a negative test result. If the test result is positive, they should isolate for 10 days.

Vaccination recommendations:

- Vaccination has been FHLC's primary goal for the 2021 MSAW season. FHLC continues to work and collaborate with employers and employees to arrange COVID-19 vaccination clinics as vaccination against COVID-19 is absolutely recommended.
- Any vaccine administered is recorded in the Wisconsin Immunization Registry (WIR) and every person vaccinated receives an immunization card. If an employer decides to make COVID-19 vaccination mandatory, they can request one of those two forms of verification from employees.
